⚠ Common Spring Weather Threats



Blizzards & Ice Storms

Heavy snowfall, strong winds, and ice can make travel dangerous and cause power outages. Keep emergency supplies in both your home and vehicle.



Thunderstorms & Tornadoes

Spring storms may bring damaging winds, hail, and tornadoes. Stay weather-aware and sign up for emergency alerts.



Lightning

Lightning can strike miles from a storm. Move indoors after thunder is heard.

- ✓ Non-perishable food & bottled water
- ✓ First-aid supplies & necessary medications
- ✓ Battery or NOAA weather radio
